Applicants must be at the **Meets Standards** Performance Level in Reading **and** Math on 7th grade ISAT (or the 65th percentile on other standardized tests). There is an initial screening of applications based on prior dramatic, vocal or instrumental experience, test scores and grades. Students who have been selected for an audition will be notified by mail and/or phone.
